At least 80% of the total crew, including the **skipper, watch captains, navigator** and any instructor serving as an advisor, of each boat planning to participate in JSA PHRF ("Big Boat") events shall attend this Safety-at-Sea Seminar. (All participants must be 14 years old by December 31, 2005.)

There is a \$40 fee for each participant for this program, which includes Donuts, Lunch & Pizza at the end of the day. All sailors MUST bring a PFD and wear boat shoes (no sandals will be allowed) since much of the day will be spent on the water.
